Is this business in a Commercial Location?

A hazardous Waste Screening Form is Required to be completed at the Florida Dept. of Health.

Is this business in a Residential Location?

Yes, but my residence is **only an office?**

A Hazardous Waste screening is **NOT** required.

I operate the business at my home and, I generate or dispose of the one or more of the following at my home:

- hazardous wastes (ie: Batteries, Solvents, Paint Products, Cleaning Solvents, Pesticides, Used Oils, and Petroleum based products)
- Biomedical Waste (Sharps or Red bag waste)

A hazardous Waste Screening Form is Required to be completed at the Florida Dept. of Health.
